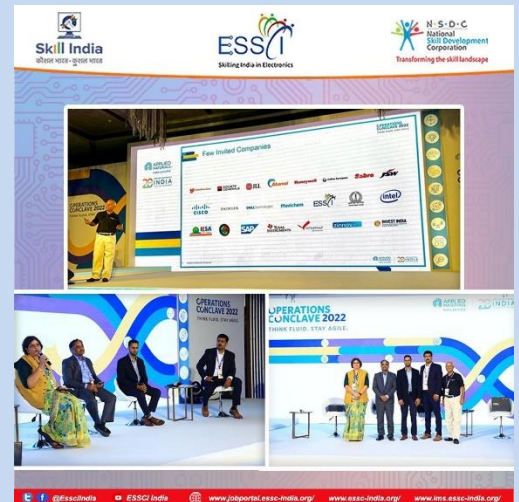
The event was attended by More than 30 universities along with the Sector Skills Councils and the experts from the academic communities who are participated in the event.

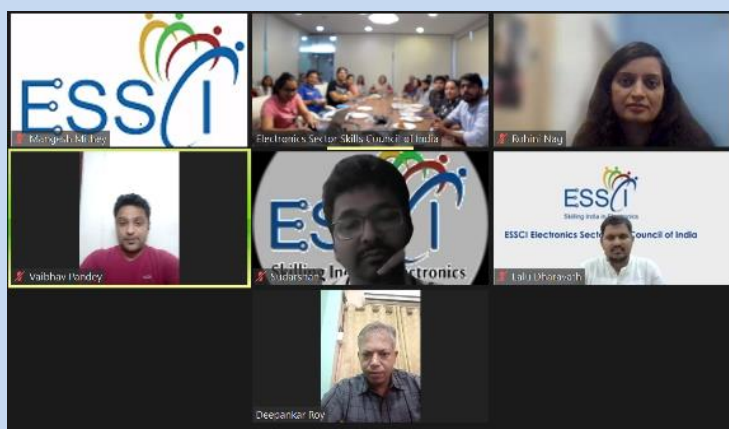
