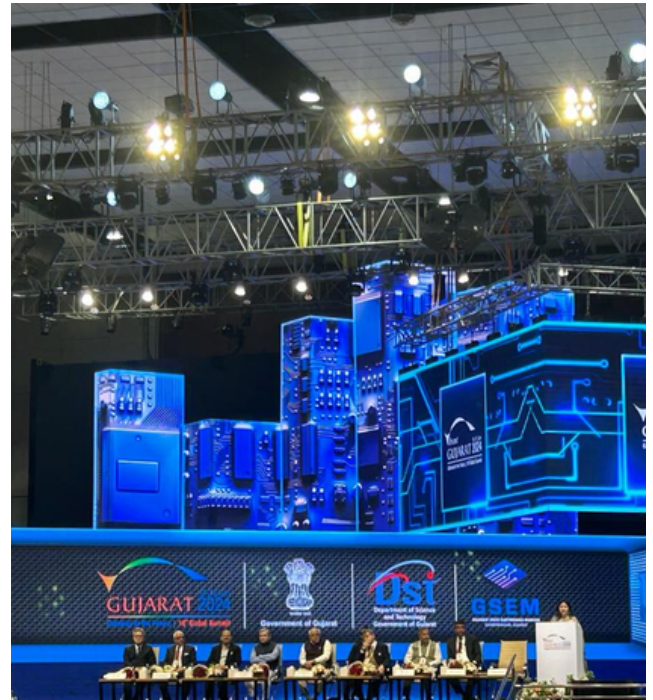


10th Edition Of Vibrant Gujarat, First In India's Amrit Kaal

INAUGURATION OF THE EVENT

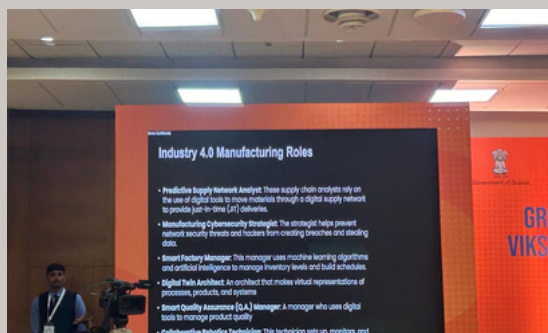

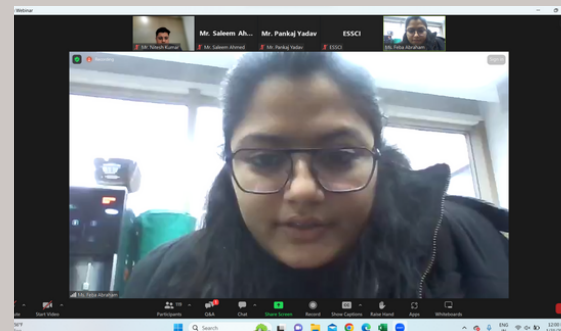
