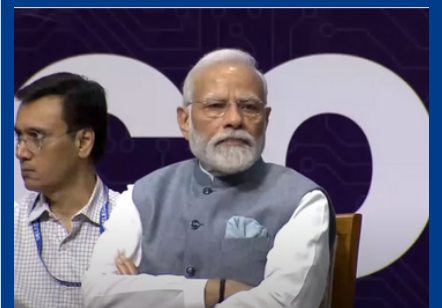

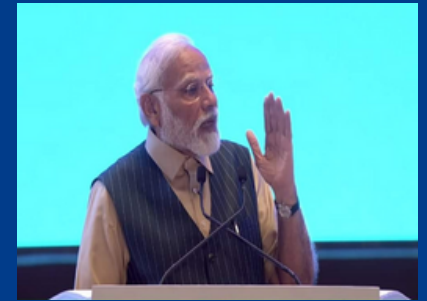


Akhil Bhartiya Shiksha Samagam
