# ESSCI Training Partners Meet, Lucknow

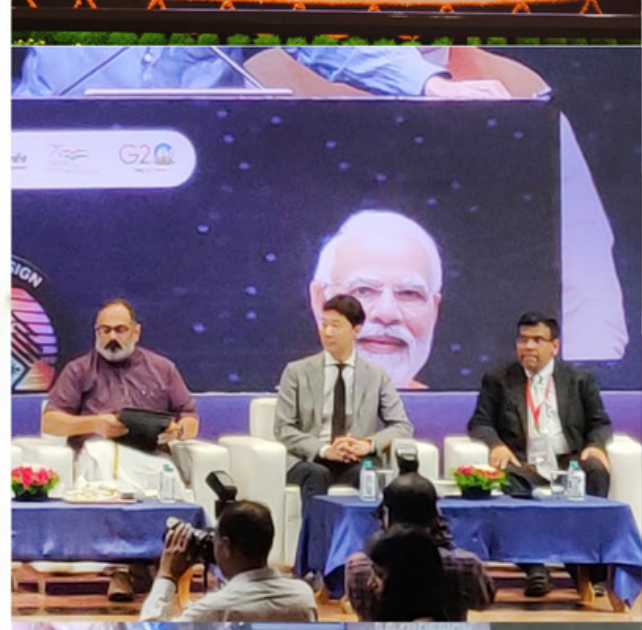


## MEETINGS & INTERACTIONS

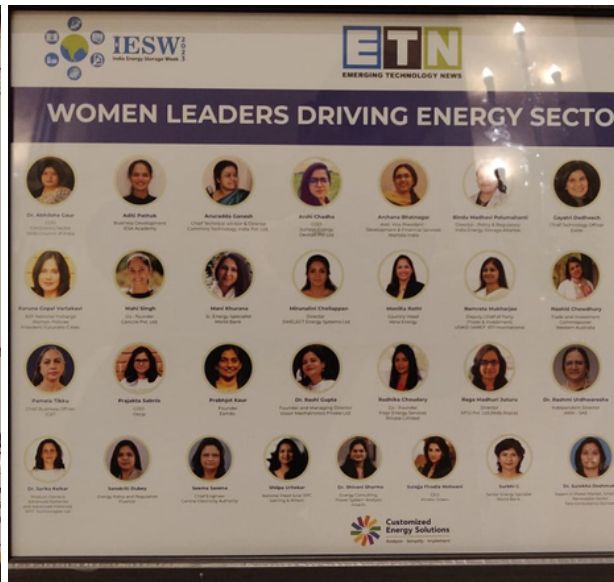
